Dr Grace Wong is the Professor of The Chinese University of Hong Kong. She graduated from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2001 with honors and distinctions in Medicine. After graduation, she received training at the division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at the Prince of Wales Hospital. In 2008, she completed her training and was awarded Fellow of the Hong Kong College of Physicians. In 2010, she received the Doctorial Degree of Medicine of the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Dr Grace Wong's main research interest includes non-invasive assessment of liver fibrosis, hepatocellular carcinoma, and chronic hepatitis B. She has published over 160 articles in peer-reviewed journals including *Gastroenterology*, *Hepatology* and *Gut*. She is currently a reviewer of 35 biomedical journals, and the editorial board members of 3 journals. She has been awarded for the Young Investigator Award of the Asian Pacific Association for the Study of the Liver in 2009, the Distinguished Research Paper Award for Young Investigators of the Hong Kong College of Physicians in 2010, 2013, 2014 and 2015, as well as the Ten Outstanding Young Persons in Hong Kong in 2014.
