

Leon Adams Biography

Leon Adams (MBBS, FRACP, PhD) is an Associate Professor in the School of Medicine and Pharmacology, University of Western Australia and Consultant Hepatologist in the Liver Transplant Unit at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital. His research areas include examining genetic and environmental risk factors for nonalcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD) and defining its liver and extra-hepatic complications. He has published over 80 peer reviewed publications and currently leads multiple investigator initiated clinical trials in NAFLD. He has been a research fellow at Mayo Clinic (Rochester, USA) and visiting scholar at the University of California, San Diego.
